



Broadway Optimist Baseball 2008 Uniform Guidelines

The purpose of having a Uniform Guideline is to promote equality among the players and teams as well as to promote the Broadway Optimist Baseball Program and give recognition to our sponsors.

Uniform Style:

1. **Shirts:** The shirt will be a standard pull-over T-shirt displaying the following:
 - a. 1 color Sponsor Logo on front
 - b. 1 color Broadway Optimist Logo on the Left Sleeve
 - c. 1 color 6 inch player number on back
 - d. Optional - 1 color Player Last name above player number on back (No nick-names) **Added cost to be paid for by the parent**
2. **Hats:** The hat will be a solid color Pro mesh cap containing a 2 color embroidered B reflective of the teams colors as determined by the Broadway Optimist Baseball Committee.
3. **Baseball Pants:** Solid Color Pants Only!
 - a. Ages 10 and under, elastic waistband with drawstring required.
 - b. Ages 11-18 belted loop requiredColors: White, Gray, Navy, Black, and Royal Blue
4. **Socks:** Two in one or solid color to match team
5. **Belt:** "Baseball" stretch belt to match uniform

Uniform Procedures and Pricing:

1. The Broadway Optimist Club pays for:
 - a. Players hat and shirt
 - b. 3 coaches hats and shirts only – additional hats and shirts may be purchased
2. All hats and shirts must be purchased through the uniform supplier selected by the Broadway Optimist Baseball Committee
3. Baseball pants and socks may be purchased by the parent or through a coordinated effort of the team. The cost of the pants and socks is the responsibility of the parent. (for ages 11-18, the cost of the Belt is also the responsibility of the parent)
4. No pinstripe pants

Penalty for Failure to comply with the Guidelines

1. First Game: Warning
2. Second and Subsequent Games: The child will not be allowed to participate
